This exercise will simulate deputies responding to the school where a subject or subjects are armed and people are injured. We will be using actors and mannequins to simulate injured people and all necessary equipment as if this is a real incident.

We are notifying the press and the public so there will not be any panic because the exercise will appear as if it is an actual incident. The Hernando County Sheriff's Office will have a sign board on Northcliffe notifying passing public of the training exercise to take place on Friday. Additionally, Public Service Aids will be going door to door in the neighborhood passing out flyers about the training exercise.
