Starting this Saturday, February 26, 2011 from 9:00 am until noon, a work contingent composed of female trustees from the Hernando County Jail will be helping to restore and maintain the landmark Spring Hill Waterfall. The group of at least three women trustees will be supervised by a uniformed Detention Deputy. They will scrape old paint, repaint fixtures, pull weeds, plant flowers and take on whatever other assignments deemed necessary to restore and then maintain the historic waterfall and grounds at the entrance of Spring Hill Drive.

Sheriff Al Nienhuis, who will be at the work site for the first hour Saturday morning, said “This is great opportunity for the Sheriff’s Office to utilize inmate labor to give back to the community. This combined effort between the Sheriff’s Office and the community will help preserve a vital landmark that has come to represent this community.”

This will be an ongoing effort; therefore, the female trustees work team will be assigned at the site every Saturday morning for the foreseeable future.
