Re: Domino Effect- Eight Arrests

Date: March 24, 2011

Arrested:

- (1) Kevin Doig, DOB 03/11/74, 7479 Pond Circle, Spring Hill, Charges- Warrants Violation of Probation and Failure to Appear
- (2) David Dawson- DOB 03/19/79, No address given , Warrant for Failure to Appear, Retail Theft, Possession of Paraphernalia, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Providing a False Name to a Law Enforcement Officer
- (3) Harry Hunt, DOB 08/26/68, 2352 Broadmoor Ln, Spring Hill, Retail Theft

On March 23, 2011, Det Dustin Mormando with went to 7479 Pond Circle in Spring Hill to follow up on a retail theft. While talking with the resident, Kevin Doig, he discovered that Doig had two outstanding warrants for his arrests. So Doig was taken into custody by Detective Mormando.

That didn't end the day for Det Mormando, as Det. Mormando was driving on Spring Hill Drive he recognized David Dawson, a suspect in retail thefts riding a bicycle. Det Mormando made contact with Dawson and asked him his name. Dawson told Det. Mormando his name was "Francis Banger". Det. Mormando knowing better, took Dawson into custody for an outstanding warrant for Failure to Appear. As Det. Mormando searched the pants pockets of Dawson he found a syringe filled with a liquid and a bottle cap with a melted blue pill. Det. Mormando found out Dawson had melted a Roxycodone pill and that he mixed a Roxycodone pill in water and filled the syringe with it to be injected. Dawson was charged with the possession of the controlled substance and paraphernalia.

Dawson was additionally charged with retail theft cases from Easy Money Pawn where he stole video games, and a retail theft at Walgreens where he stole cigarettes. Also, Dawson was charged with providing a false name of "Francis Banger" to Det Mormando. When Dawson was arrested he was riding on his friend bicycle and requested the bicycle be turned over to the owner, Harry Hunt.

Hunt was contacted and came to where Det. Mormando had Dawson under arrest. It just so happened that Hunt was also a suspect in a retail theft so Det. Mormando questioned him about the theft and when Hunt confessed Hunt was taken into custody. His bicycle was put into property for safe keeping for him.
