The incident started on 03/31/11, 12:12 pm, when Hernando County Deputies responded to the area of Lehouier Drive and Eastside Drive in Brooksville reference to a report of shots being fired and a person being shot. When deputies arrived they discovered a deceased male in the yard of 1583 Howell Ave, Brooksville. The deceased was later identified as Kenardo Frazer who lived at 21375 Anderson Rd, Brooksville.

Detectives began their investigation and through interviews developed suspects. During the evening hours of 03/31/11 the suspects were located and brought to the Sheriff's Office. The interrogations revealed the following information leading to the arrest of Julius Holder, Dunell Brown and Charles Bottom.

On 03/31/2011 before noon, Julius Holder was contacted by Dunell Brown and told to bring a firearm to his residence. Julius Holder along with Charles Bottom drove to Brown's residence at 21375 Anderson Road, Brooksville Florida. Holder was advised of a conflict that was occurring between the victim and Dunell Brown. Holder then drove to 10438 Eastside Ave, Brooksville, and retrieved his .9mm handgun and returned to 21375 Anderson Road, Brooksville. Holder, along with Brown and Bottom chased the victim while he ran on foot. All three defendants were occupying a motor vehicle being driven by Julius Holder while pursuing the victim. The victim ran through several yards in the neighborhood momentarily loosing the defendants. The defendants then saw the victim running through the yard at 1583 Howell Avenue Brooksville. All three defendants exited the vehicle and ran behind a vacant house at 21390 Lehouier Drive, Brooksville to intercept the victim. At this point Julius Holder shot the victim two times with his .9mm handgun causing the victim's death. All three defendants then ran back to the vehicle and left the area.

Holder, Brown and Bottom were transported to the Hernando County Jail held without bond.
