**ARRESTED:**

(1) JERRY C. GOODRICH, DOB 07/25/82, 12468 Harper St. Spring Hill.

(2) JASON R MAYNARD, DOB 08/01/79, 3271 Horseshoe Lane, Spring Hill

Both Charged with Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, Bond \$50,000.00

On 04/01/11, at 9:03 pm, Hernando County Deputies responded to a commercial robbery at The Restaurant located at 3438 Commercial Way, Spring Hill. A search with helicopter, deputies and K-9 were unsuccessful at the time.

In the early morning hours on 04/02/11 an anonymous phone call was received by Communications which lead deputies to the address of 3271 Horseshoe Lane where the suspects from the robbery were located.

GOODRICH and MAYNARD were transported to the Hernando County Sheriff's Office and after interviews detectives determined the following.

GOODRICH entered the restaurant armed with a knife and demanded money, while MAYNARD waited in the car. Before GOODRICH came out of the restaurant, MAYNARD drove away. GOODRICH came out of the restaurant couldn't find MAYNARD so he had to flee on foot from the robbery. That was when a witness spotted him running eastbound from the location towards Horseshoe and Toucan Trail.

GOODRICH and MAYNARD were arrested, each has been charged with Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, and both were transported to the Hernando County Jail, and held on a bond of \$50,000.00. The money obtained from the robbery was used for drugs.

This case is continuing so information is limited.
