Re: Operation Glory Daze Second Warrant Round Up Nets 21
Additional Arrests

For background, the first three paragraphs below are information from a previous release.

An anonymous tip about passing of fraudulent prescriptions at the Glory Pharmacy in June 2010 has culminated in warrants for the arrest of sixty-six people for trafficking drugs.

During the course of the investigation of the Glory Pharmacy by the Hernando County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Unit, the investigation got to the point that an Undercover Detective was able to have a fraudulent prescription filled for 240 Oxycodone paying the pharmacy nine hundred forty (\$940) cash. The Undercover Detectives went back the next day with another fraudulent prescription for 240 Oxycodone and were able to get the pills after paying \$1,250 cash for them.

On October 12, 2010, a search warrant was served at Glory Pharmacy by the Hernando County sheriff's Office with the assistance of the Federal Drug Enforcement Administration and the Florida Department of Health. All medications, computers, prescription related documents were seized. Arrested at that time was the pharmacy owner OLUBODE I. OLATUNJI.

New Information:

On Thursday, June 30, 2011, the Hernando County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Unit conducted their second warrant round up for Operation Glory Daze. With the assistance of the Pasco County Sheriff's Office Warrants section, a total of 21 subjects were arrested. After yesterdays' warrant round up, a total of 100 arrests have been made since the beginning of the Operation Glory Daze case was initiated in October 2010. Currently 6 subjects from the second warrant round up have outstanding warrants. Unfortunately, 2 subjects who were originally under investigation have been confirmed as deceased --1 of which died from a drug overdose. This investigation is continuing and more arrests are planned in the near future with a third Operation Glory Daze Warrant Round Up.
