Public Service Aide Academy

The Hernando County Sheriff's Office Citizen Volunteer Corps is now accepting applications for the Public Service Aide (PSA) Program. The PSA program is an exceptional volunteer opportunity that provides a higher level of training and a greater sense of satisfaction due to the position's increased responsibility. PSA's volunteer in the patrol division and handle minor calls for service from citizens and assist patrol deputies with non-emergency calls.

Some of the duties include responding to abandoned vehicles, traffic direction, misdemeanor criminal mischief complaints, and other designated calls for service.

Candidates can expect a law enforcement style classroom training which will prepare them for an 80 hour field training program. They will then be released to full PSA status.

Applications are available in person at the Hernando County Sheriff's Office in Brooksville and at the Sheriff's District II office on Forest Oaks Blvd. The deadline for application submission for the next PSA Academy is August 31, 2011.
