The Hernando County Sheriff's Office is currently accepting applications for part-time School Crossing Guards. School Crossing Guards are responsible for providing supervision of pedestrian and traffic control at specific school locations throughout Hernando County. They will also assist in helping direct traffic flow at their designated school, as well as ensure the safety of the children before and after school hours.

The ideal candidate will possess a High School Diploma or equivalent. Candidates must also possess knowledge of or the ability to learn basic traffic laws and safety procedures. Physical skills needed to perform the job include the ability to stand for long periods of time, and acceptable eyesight and hearing (with or without correction).
