The Hernando County Sheriff's Office is seeking the help from the citizen's in the Tampa Bay area in identifying a bank robbery suspect. On Friday, 12/10/10 at 3:25 p.m. a bank robbery occurred at the SunTrust Bank located at 1170 Mariner Blvd., Spring Hill. The suspect was last seen on foot and was not located.
