The 2011-2012 Hernando County Sheriff's Office Resource Calendar was recently distributed in a local newspaper. Sheriff Al Nienhuis and his staff wanted to create something different -- something that could be used as a guideline throughout the year. Inside the calendar citizens can learn about crime prevention, as well as personal and holiday safety. It also provides information about the services offered from our agency, such as the Senior Safety Cell Phone program, the Citizen's Academy, the Sheriff's Summer Camp, and our Careline program. In addition, this calendar offers interesting facts about programs such as Community Policing, School Resource Officers, Emergency Management, SWAT, and more. Our proposed budget for 2012 is also illustrated in an easy to understand graph.

The calendar was funded through the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF). The LETF is strictly funded with proceeds of seized or forfeited cash and property from criminals. Florida State Statute 932.7055 governs the use of this fund and allows law enforcement agencies to use the proceeds for crime prevention, promoting safe neighborhoods, and drug abuse education and prevention programs. No monies are taken from the Sheriff's Office Budget to print or distribute this calendar; therefore, it does not cost the taxpayers any money.

If you did not receive a calendar and would like one, you may pick one up at the Hernando County Sheriff's Office in Brooksville or at our office on Forest Oaks Blvd in Springhill. Quantities are limited; therefore, we ask that you only take one per household.
