On 08282011 at approximately 10:00 pm, an elderly female was robbed of her purse after she pulled her car into the garage of her Spring Hill home. The suspect rushed the victim as she was getting out of her vehicle, then pulled the victim to the ground when she would not release her purse. The suspect then fled with the victim's purse and left the injured victim on the floor of her garage. The victim could not get up and laid on the floor for at least 30 minutes yelling for help. A neighbor finally found her and called 911. The victim was transported to the hospital where she was treated for significant injuries to her arm and leg as a result of the suspect's actions.

On 09082011, while conducting an unrelated robbery investigation, detectives recovered the victim's purse at Anthony Jones' residence. During a subsequent interview Anthony denied committing this robbery however he made statements with details that only someone that was involved in this offense would know.

“Anthony Jones targeted elderly citizens and his second arrest is a tremendous victory for the senior's citizens of Hernando County” said Sheriff Al Nienhuis. Jones is currently being housed at the Hernando County Detention Center and is now being held on a total bond of \$110,000.
