On November 02, 2011, the Hernando County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Unit conducted a search warrant on a 1999 Monaco Executive Motorhome owned and lived in by Harold Sleight. The motorhome was seized from Topics RV Park in Spring Hill, in conjunction with the original search warrant involving the Hope Pain Management Group.

The following medications were found inside the motorhome and were not prescribed to Mr. Sleight:

- 39.5 Oxycodone pills (schedule 2) weighing 18.1 grams
- 10 Oxycodone pills (schedule 2) weighing 1.1 grams
- 4 Oxycodone pills (schedule 2) weighing .5 grams
- 13 Temazepam (Schedule 4) weighing 3.6 grams
- 18 Lorazepam (Schedule 4) weighing 1.6 grams

Mr. Sleight was charged with:

COUNT I : Trafficking in a controlled substance, to-wit; Oxycodone with a count of 53.5 tablets, in the amount of a total of 19.7 grams, in violation of Florida State Statue 893.135(1)(c).

COUNT II-III: Possession of a Controlled Substance to wit: Temazepam and Lorazepam, both being a Schedule IV Controlled Substance, in violation of Florida State Statue 893.13.

Sleight was arrested and transported to the Hernando County Jail without incident. His bond was set at \$110,000. **Sleight relinquished his license to the Department of Health and will no longer be able to practice medicine.**
