Re: Marijuana and Froot Loops Lead to Felony Arrest

Date: July 9, 2014

On 07-03-14, Logan Brown and Christopher Ramos decided it would be a good idea to smoke some marijuana. Right after that, the pair decided to "go on an adventure" and break into the Challenger K-8 School located at 13400 Elgin Boulevard in Spring Hill.

Before entering the school, the pair attempted to conceal their identities by partially covering their faces and heads.

Once inside the school, Brown and Ramos wandered the halls, looked into classrooms, and went on their "adventure." Finally, they stole Froot Loops cereal from a room that was open inside the school.

Detective Robert Desmond was assigned the case. In an effort to solve the case in an expedient manner, Detective Desmond requested that Crime Analysis formulate a bulletin utilizing still images that were extracted from surveillance video at the school. The images and bulletins were promptly posted on the HCSO Facebook page and distributed via Community Alert Bulletin.

As expected, within minutes of posting the images, numerous tips were received via Crime Stoppers identifying the suspects responsible for the crime.

On 07-08-14, Detective Robert Desmond and Detective Dane Jenkins were able to locate both individuals responsible for the crime and place them under arrest. They are as follows:

- Logan Brown W/M DOB/03-18-1996
 - Burglary to Unoccupied Structure
- Christopher Ramos W/M DOB/09-10-1993
 - o Burglary to Unoccupied Structure.
