Re: HCSO Air Unit Assists With Two Incidents in Trillium

Date: December 21, 2015

On 12-18-15 at 11:26 p.m., 911 dispatchers received a call regarding a possible commercial burglary in progress at 2023 Trillium Blvd., in the Trillium subdivision, Brooksville.

When deputies arrived, they spotted an SUV parked in the driveway of the house, which is still under construction. Deputies then heard noise coming from the rear of the property. As they approached, several individuals were spotted running from the house.

The HCSO Air Unit was called in to assist with the search for the suspects.

Two of the suspects, Mariah Barr (W/F DOB 12/2/2000) and Chanell Roberts (W/F DOB 11/14/2000) were arrested following a short foot chase.

The remaining three suspects, **Anthony Martinez** (W/M DOB 11/6/93), **Anthony Rosario** (W/M DOB 11/4/98) and **Brandon Martinez** (W/M DOB 8/8/99) were all apprehended a short time later.

All five suspects were charged with **Burglary of a Dwelling**, which is a felony.

During questioning, the suspects told deputies they went to the empty house to hangout. Deputies noted nothing inside the house was damaged; however, a screen to one of the windows had been cut.

In a separate incident, on 12-19-15 shortly after midnight, deputies who were assisting on the commercial burglary incident were notified of a possible home burglary at 855 Sea Holly Drive, which is also located in the Trillium subdivision.

The homeowner arrived home to find Aiden Fogarty (W/M DOB 11/12/98) in the garage area taking beers from a refrigerator. The homeowner had left the garage door open. Fogarty fled the area upon being spotted. The Air Unit was called to assist with locating the suspect.

Fogarty ran between several houses and through retention ponds in an attempt to escape. The Air Unit tracked Fogarty as he fled and was able to direct ground units to his location on Alpine Thistle Drive where he was arrested.

Fogarty told deputies when he saw the garage door open he planned on taking a few beers from the refrigerator and some cigarettes on a nearby table. When the homeowner spotted him, he decided to flee.

Fogarty is charged with **Burglary of a Dwelling and Resisting** an **Officer Without Violence**.
