
SITUATION

Damage Assessment Teams conducted initial impact assessments throughout the county on Saturday, September 3rd and Sunday, September 4th. Further details are included below. This information will be provided to local and state officials to assist in recovery efforts.

Scattered showers and thunderstorms in the area. Partly sunny, with a high near 89. Heat index values as high as 97. North-northwest wind around 6 mph. Chance of precipitation is 40%. New rainfall amounts between a tenth and quarter of an inch, except higher amounts possible in thunderstorms.

POSSIBLE IMPACTS

At this time the Withlacoochee River remains below action stage.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

 Residents are reminded to be aware of possible hazards as a result of the storm, such as loose or dangling tree branches, damaged utility lines, tripping hazards, dislocated wildlife, hazardous materials, submerged sharp-edged debris.

DEBRIS DISPOSAL

Hernando County Solid Waste/West Hernando Convenience Center, located at 2525 Osowaw Blvd. in Spring Hill, will be open on Monday, September 5 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The ramp to access the facility can accommodate 5" x 10" trailers and smaller.

These extended and holiday hours are to accommodate Hernando County residents who wish to dispose of trash and debris caused by Hurricane Hermine.
