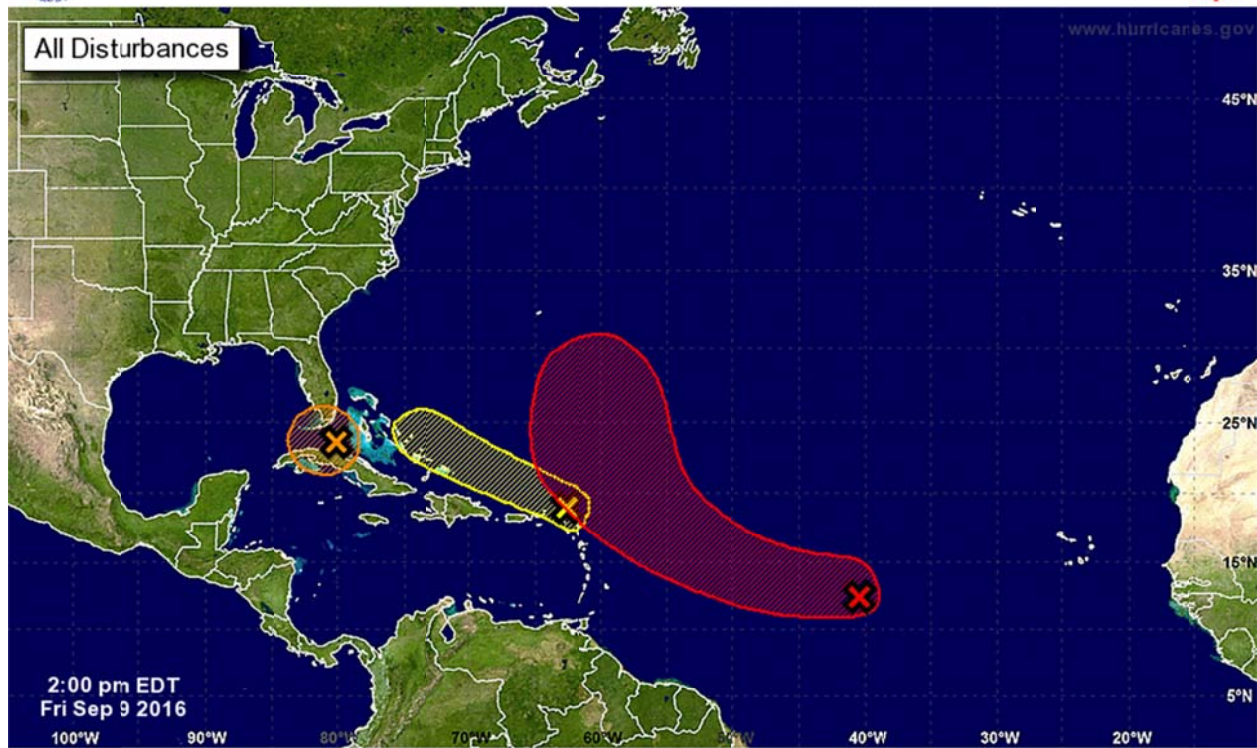

The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) is monitoring renewed activity in the tropics. There are currently **3 tropical waves** in the Atlantic Ocean tracking west-northwest. Residents are urged to actively monitor for further developments.

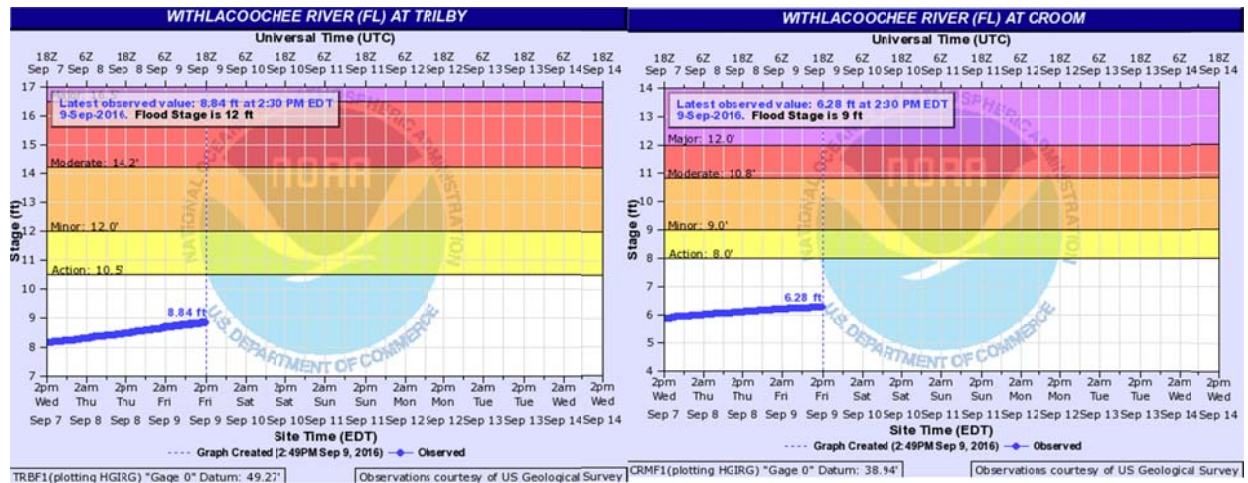

River gauges indicate that the Withlacoochee River continues to slowly rise. Residents living near the river are advised to continue to monitor river levels.

- The Withlacoochee River at Trilby is currently at 8.84 feet. Action stage is 10.5 feet.
- The Withlacoochee River at Croom is currently at 6.28 feet. Action stage is 8 feet.

State/FEMA Public Damage Assessment

State/FEMA damage assessment teams are in Hernando County today conducting private property damage assessments to confirm the damages reported by Hernando County.

A final determination from FEMA regarding assistance will be made following the completion of these assessments.

Pine Island Park

The Hernando County Parks and Recreation Department announces that cleanup at Pine Island Park is completed and it will reopen Saturday, September 10. Parking pay stations are temporarily unavailable. The \$5 parking fee will be collected by on-duty staff. Cash payments are preferred due to limited availability of electronic pay machines. Efforts continue to ensure that our parks are restored to a safe and attractive condition following the damage caused by Hurricane Hermine.

Debris Collection

Debris collection is continuing in the **coastal areas** of Hernando County. Residents are **reminded** of the following guidelines:

- Residents are asked to place any storm-generated debris on the public right-of-way. Per our debris contractor, please set out debris for the first pass no later than **Monday, September 12, 2016**.
- The public right-of-way is the area of residential property that extends from the street to the sidewalk, ditch, utility pole, or easement. Do not place debris on the roadway. Keep vegetative debris (woody burnable debris such as limbs and shrubbery) separated from construction and demolition debris and white goods (refrigerators, washers, dryers) as they will be collected separately. Bagged debris should not be placed on the public right-of-way; only loose debris will be collected.
- Do not place near water meter, fire hydrant or any other aboveground utility. Only debris placed on the public right-of-way will be eligible for collection until further notice.

If all debris is not picked up during the initial pass, please continue to push remaining debris to the right-of-way for collection on subsequent passes. Household garbage will be collected by your normal service provider on usual collection dates.
