Re: Detectives Take Down Another Drug Trafficker

Date: September 13, 2016

On 09-13-16, detectives with the Hernando County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Unit, along with members of the SWAT Team, executed a search warrant at 6413 Post Court in Spring Hill, the residence of Eric Green.

The search warrant was the result of a lengthy investigation where undercover Vice and Narcotic detectives were able to purchase controlled substances from Green on several occasions.

At approximately 9:30 a.m., detectives made contact with Green and several other individuals inside the residence. All individuals were taken into custody without incident.

Pursuant to the search, detectives located several baggies containing controlled substances, a baggie containing cocaine, drug paraphernalia and two firearms, one of which was reported stolen from the South Florida area.

While on the scene, several neighbors expressed their gratitude to detectives for their efforts on the case. Many in the area had growing concerns regarding the activity which included heavy amounts of traffic to and from the residence.
