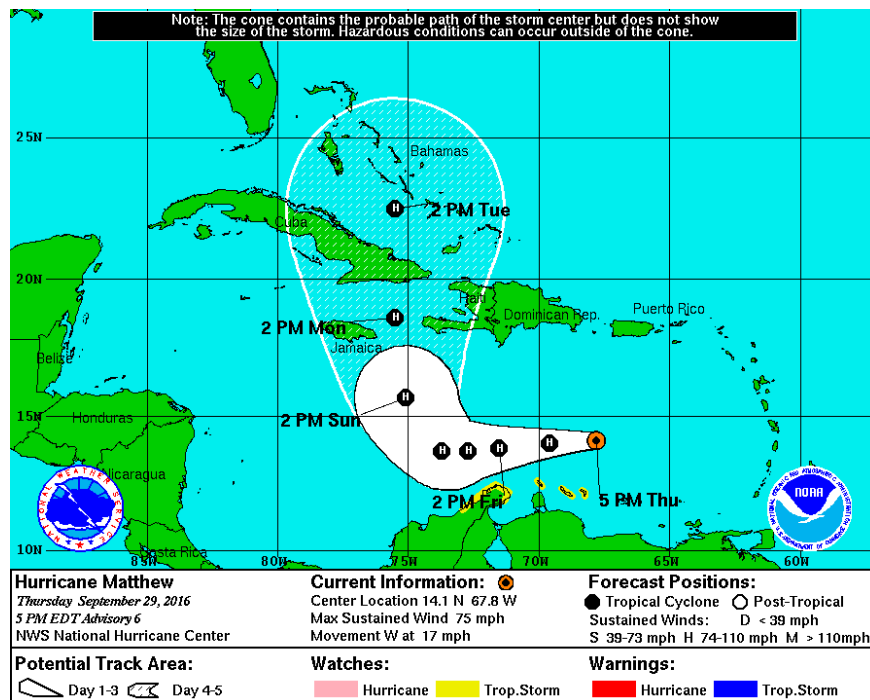
#### **SITUATION**
