

# National Weather Service Tampa Bay Area, Florida



### Significant Weather Briefing

January 6-9, 2017

**Overview:** Multiple potential weather hazards will impact west-central and southwest Florida through the upcoming weekend. A strong cold front approaching the region tonight into Saturday morning will first bring the potential for thunderstorms, some possibly strong from Tampa Bay northward. In the wake of the front later Saturday, hazardous boating conditions will quickly develop across the eastern Gulf of Mexico. Finally, some of the coldest air so far this winter season will descend upon the region for Saturday Night through early Monday morning.

#### **Thunderstorm Impacts:**

- ☐ Tampa Bay and northward
  - Isolated Damaging Wind Gust
  - Frequent Lightning
  - Brief Heavy rainfall
- ☐ South of Tampa Bay
  - Frequent Lightning
  - Brief Heavy rainfall


Severe Weather Outlook For Friday Night & Saturday AM



#### **Rainfall Impacts:**

Overall flooding from rainfall is not a major concern tonight into Saturday. A widespread ½" to 1" rainfall event is expected. Localized street flooding can always occur with individual thunderstorms, but widespread areal flooding is not anticipated.

#### □ Temperatures:


- Near freezing temperatures in Levy County (Freeze warnings possible).
- 30s as far south as Hillsborough/Polk Counties.
- Low to Middle 40s for counties south of Tampa Bay.


#### ■ Wind Chills Values:

- 20s north of I-4 corridor early Sunday and Monday mornings.
- 30s all zones south of I-4 corridor.


### Wind Chill Advisory Criteria:


- Hernando/Sumter/Citrus/Levy: 25°F or below
- Pasco County southward to Lee County: 35°F or below.

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
