**SITUATION**

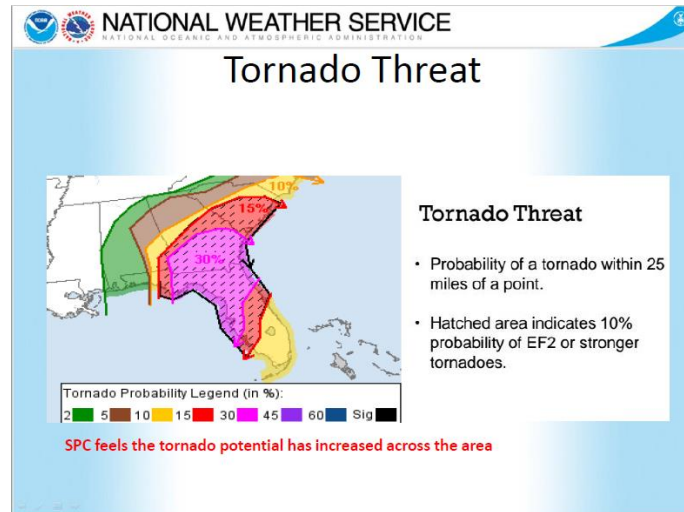
The National Weather Service is tracking a strengthening area of low pressure and associated cold front will move across the southeast U.S. The Severe Weather Threat timing for Hernando County has been changed to estimate the main portion to impact the County about 7 to 10pm.

**POSSIBLE IMPACTS**

- A few strong, long-track tornadoes will be possible especially from Tampa Bay north
- Strong Straight line winds of 60 to 80 mph and hail can also be expected
- Tornado threat increased to 30%
- Wind threat increased to 80%
- Hail threat increased to 30%
- Wind gust possible 29 to 25mph throughout Monday
- Coastal tide levels 2-3 ft above normal

**RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

- Mobile home residents are encouraged to follow their plans to seek shelter in a substantial structure until the tornado and wind threat has passed.
- Coastal residents should closely monitor the progress of this system through local media outlets, the National Weather Service at <http://www.srh.noaa.gov/tbw/> .
- Check emergency supply kits, and ensure plans and preparations to secure personal property are complete.
