The National Weather Service has issued a **Freeze Warning**, which is in effect from 2 AM to 9 AM on Thursday.

Cold Temperatures

A much colder and drier air mass will move over our area tonight through Friday. This cold air mass will support the possibility of sub-freezing temperatures across Hernando County late Wednesday night into early Thursday morning. Low temperatures between 27 to 32 degrees are expected Thursday morning.

RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

- Consider the needs of pets during this time. Do not leave pets outside in the cold weather.
- Cover or move plants that are sensitive to the cold indoors.
- Residents are encouraged to pay attention to local media outlets or the National Weather Service at http://www.srh.noaa.gov/tbw/ for current weather information.
