Summer is right around the corner, and the Hernando County Sheriff's Office is again planning to offer **R.O.A.R. Summer Day Camps** for **Hernando County children**, ages 6-12.

Sheriff's R.O.A.R. Summer Day Camp applications are available today, Monday, May 1, 2017.

All sessions at each location will run from **Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.** It is an action packed, fun-filled week for kids, ages 6-12 years. It is FREE to the first 60 registered campers each week. Preference will be given to students who have NEVER attended camp. (Each child may only attend **one** week-long session.)

Camps will be held at the following locations:

Session 1 – Nature Coast High School – **June 5-9, 2017** Session 2 – Parrott Middle School – **June 12-16, 2017** Session 3 – Weeki Wachee High School – **June 19-23, 2017** Session 4 – Nature Coast High School – **June 26-30, 2017**.
