The Hernando County Sheriff's Office is requesting assistance from our media partners and the community in locating a **MISSING ENDANGERED ADULT**. A Purple Alert has been issued.

Alexander Garcia was last seen at approximately 1 a.m. on 01-28-24 in the area of his residence on Pinehurst Drive, near Lodge Circle, in Spring Hill.

Garcia's physical description is as follows:

Race – H Sex – M DOB – 07-09-1990 Height – 5'10" Weight – 260 Eyes – Brown

Hair – Bald

Clothing - White basketball shorts and a grey shirt.

Purple Alerts are issued for Missing Adults who meet one or more of the criteria listed below.

- The individual has a mental or cognitive disability that is not Alzheimer's disease or a dementia related disorder; an intellectual or developmental disability (brain injury, physical/mental/emotional disability not related to substance abuse, or any combination of these).
- The disappearance indicates a credible threat of immediate danger or serious bodily harm to him or herself, as determined by local law enforcement.
- The individual cannot be returned to safety without law enforcement intervention.
- The individual does not meet the criteria for activation of a local Silver Alert or the Silver Alert Plan of the Department of Law Enforcement.
