Anyone participating in the TNVR program must read the following:

- If you did not make an appointment, the feral cat will not be seen.
- Feral cats will be accepted ONLY when contained in a cat trap. Cats in crates or carriers will not be accepted.
- Drop Off – Between 8:00 – 8:15 a.m.
- Pick Up – Between 3:00 – 5:30 p.m.
- Maximum of two cats per Hernando County resident

TNVR Scheduling

TNVR surgeries are performed on
WEDNESDAYS only. **An appointment
is required.**

Please Note...

All TNVR cats must enter and leave the
shelter on the same day. We are unable
to hold feral cats for any longer than a
few hours after their surgery.



Trap, Neuter, Vaccinate, and Return

- TNVR is a humane and effective method for managing community cat populations by trapping, neutering, vaccinating, and returning cats to their original territories.
- TNVR helps stabilize and reduce the population by preventing new kittens from being born, and also addresses nuisance behaviors like yowling and fighting.
- TNVR also reduces calls to Animal Enforcement Officers and lowers euthanasia rates, saving cat's lives and taxpayer dollars.
