On 05-14-18 at approximately 4:06 a.m., a Commercial Robbery occurred at the Lucky U gaming establishment, located at 5165 Commercial Way in Spring Hill.

An employee, who was still inside the business, advised deputies that a male, possibly a black male, wearing a hoodie and a stocking mask entered the business and demanded money. The suspect, who was last seen wearing black jeans and a black shirt, fled the area by unknown means.

The employee was not injured during the robbery.
