Re: Shooting - 813 Twigg Street

Date: January 4, 2019

On 01-03-19 just after 11 a.m., Hernando County Sheriff's deputies and Hernando County Fire Rescue were dispatched to a reported Shooting at 813 Twigg Street in Brooksville.

Upon arrival, deputies located the victim, later identified as Thomas Holland, sitting in a chair in the middle of the street, near 813 Twigg Street. Holland had been shot in the leg. Holland was not cooperative with the investigation.

Holland was transported to a local trauma center for treatment of the gunshot wound(s).

Deputies and detectives canvassed the area for information, witness accounts, etc. All individuals who were in the area at the time of the shooting refused to provide witness statements, as they claimed to have not seen or heard anything pertaining to the crime.

Forensics Specialists processed the scene for physical evidence.

The investigation is ongoing. There is no additional information available at this time.
