Re: Vice and Narcotics Search Warrant – 10076 Sunburst Court

Date: June 17, 2019

On o6-14-19, members of the Hernando County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Unit executed a search warrant at 10076 Sunburst Court in Spring Hill.

Investigation revealed that the resident, Luis Daniel Laureano Santiago, was involved in distributing methamphetamines and prescription medications from the residence.

During a search of the residence, detectives located the following:

- 2.0 grams of marijuana
- 5.7 grams of methamphetamines
- 7.3 grams of various prescription medications
- 0.3 grams of cocaine
- Ammunition (various types)

The Office of Sheriff:

The Office of the Sheriff is established by the Florida Constitution. As a constitutional officer, the Sheriff has the exclusive authority to administer his or her agency and is responsible for preserving the peace throughout the entire county, carrying out the laws of the state, the orders of Florida courts, and the ordinances of the Board of County Commissioners.
