The Hernando County Sheriff's Office is requesting assistance from our media partners and the community in locating a **MISSING ENDANGERED ADULT**.


Gary Litaker was last seen on **07-19-19** following a breakup with his girlfriend at which time he made threats to harm himself. No one has seen or heard from him since.

The Office of Sheriff:

The Sheriff is the chief law enforcement and correctional officer of the county.

Sheriff Al Nienhuis was initially appointed as the Sheriff of Hernando County by the Governor in January of 2011. He was then elected by the people of Hernando County in 2012, and remains accountable to them.
