Re: K-9 Meck Completes Narcotics Detection School - Locates Illegal Narcotics

Date: May 14, 2020

On 05-13-20, Detectives J. Desmond and R. Killingsworth conducted a Traffic Stop near the intersection of West Jefferson Street and East Avenue in Brooksville.

Based on their investigation, the detectives requested a K-9 team respond to the scene of the stop.

Deputy J. Weeks and K-9 Meck, who both completed Narcotic Detection School on Friday, 05-08-20, responded to the scene to conduct a "sniff" of the vehicle.

K-9 Meck alerted to the presence of illegal narcotics in the vehicle; a search was then conducted.

As a result of the search, detectives located the following:

- Methamphetamine 5.3 grams
- Hashish Wax 30.6 grams
- Marijuana 32.6 grams
- Drug Paraphernalia Numerous items
- Ammunition 24 rounds of .223.

The driver of the vehicle, **Nicholas Lewis DOB/12-07-65**, was placed under arrest. Lewis was charged as follows:

- Possession of Methamphetamine
- Possession of Hashish
- Possession of Paraphernalia
- Possession of Ammunition by a Convicted Felon.

Great job by K-9 Meck, only days after completing his training.

The Office of Sheriff:
