Re: Absconded Sexual Predator – Chester Dzikowski

The Hernando County Sheriff's Office is seeking assistance from the public in locating an **Absconded Sexual Predator.**

Chester Dzikowski W/M DOB/04-16-1980 is no longer residing at his last known address of 16089 Fruitville Street in Brooksville. Dzikowski's current whereabouts are unknown.

Dzikowski may be driving or traveling in a blue 2002 Chevy S10 pickup, bearing Florida tag/PCXA29.

Dzikowski is a registered sexual predator and is required to report his residential address/location to law enforcement.

Probable cause exists for the arrest of Dzikowski with an arrest warrant forthcoming.

The Office of Sheriff:

The Office of the Sheriff is established by the Florida Constitution. Sheriff Al Nienhuis was initially appointed as the Sheriff of Hernando County by the Governor in January of 2011. He was then elected by the people of Hernando County in 2012, ran unopposed in 2016, and remains accountable to them.
