Re:	Spring Hill Burglary Investigation Leads to Two Arrests – 2023-31905
Date:	October 11, 2023

On 10-06-2023, Hernando County Sheriff's deputies responded to a report of a burglary at 1338 Battersea Avenue in Spring Hill.

When deputies arrived, they witnessed two males outside of the residence standing next to a vehicle with the hood raised. These males were identified as Jason Earon Williams DOB/07-03-1981 and Michael Aaron Kiselyk DOB/04-15-1993. On the ground, deputies also observed vehicle parts and several tools. The vehicle was not owned or registered to either Williams or Kiselyk.

Williams and Kiselyk admitted to removing parts from the vehicle using the tools observed at the scene, which Williams stated he had brought with him. Williams stated one of the parts he removed from the vehicle was located in his work back pack, which was on the ground next to his tools.

Williams consented to allow deputies to search his back pack, where they found the car part as well as several debit, credit, and social security cards. Numerous cards were in his own name, as well as the names of 15 other individuals. Williams stated he had the cards with the names of other persons and was holding them for safe-keeping. Williams stated, as a contractor, he locates cards in residences and old vehicles and adds them to his "collection". Many of the debit and credit cards were still valid and had not expired.

Williams and Kiselyk were arrested, transported to Hernando County Detention Center and charged as follows:

Jason Earon Williams - Bond \$25,000

- Burglary of Unoccupied Dwelling
- Possession of Burglary Tools with Intent To Use
- Unlawful Possession of Personal ID (5 or More)

Michael Aaron Kiselyk – Bond \$12,500

- Burglary of Unoccupied Dwelling
- Possession of Burglary Tools with Intent To Use
