Re: Shooting Investigation – El Sol de Mexico - Cortez Boulevard – 2024 00214032

Date: July 31, 2024

On 07-30-24 at approximately 10:10 a.m., Hernando County Sheriff's deputies, along with Hernando County Fire Rescue were dispatched to the El Sol de Mexico restaurant, located at 31079 Cortez Boulevard in Brooksville, regarding a Shooting.

The caller, a representative of the restaurant, advised the 9-1-1 operator that a black male was inside the establishment and had shot people who were also inside.

Immediately following the Shooting, the male fled to a nearby vehicle and left the area in an unknown direction of travel. The vehicle was described by witnesses as a small black vehicle with Georgia tags.

Upon arrival on scene, deputies obtained a complete description of the suspect and the vehicle he fled in. Additionally, deputies immediately reviewed surveillance video in order to confirm the information that was provided. Deputies obtained a photo of the vehicle in question, which was promptly provided to other law enforcement agencies via the HCSO Crime Analysis Unit.

Shortly thereafter, Troopers with the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) observed a vehicle matching the description of the suspect vehicle and conducted a Traffic Stop. Upon making contact with the driver, Troopers observed that he too matched the description that was provided of the suspect.

Troopers detained the male and transported him to the HCSO for interview.

The male refused to speak with detectives.

While in an interview room at the HCSO with detectives and a forensic specialist, the suspect attempted to escape from custody. He was immediately detained and charged accordingly.

As a result of the investigation, including surveillance video, and physical evidence, the male, identified as **Donald Donell Jamison DOB/09-11-2002** was placed under arrest and charged as follows:

- First Degree Murder
- Attempted First Degree Murder
- Robbery (2 counts)
- Attempted Escape from Law Enforcement
- NO BOND.

Two persons who were making a delivery to the business were shot during the incident. They are identified as follows:

- Victim #1 – **Claudia Barbosa DOB/01-05-1971** (*mother*) – Deceased
- Victim #2 – **Nicolas Bello DOB/08-26-1995** (*son*) – Non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives will be working through the next several days to develop a time line leading up to the Shooting.
