Scholarship Goal:

To grant a high-impact scholarship to enable a person to obtain an education (2-year, 4-year, technical, or trade school) that they may not be able to do on their own or with the means at hand. This is not for post-baccalaureate education.

Scholarship Terms:

- This scholarship is only open to **Hernando County High School Seniors**.
- This is a competitive scholarship, not all applicants will receive funding.
- This scholarship will weigh applications based on demonstrated need, program of study, as well as the other information requested in the application.
- This scholarship may be applied to a new enrollment or to allow a student to complete a program already in progress.
- Only one scholarship per year per candidate will be awarded.

Application Requirements:

- Completed applications containing all information must be returned to **no later than May 1, 2026.**

Application must contain:

- A copy of your transcript;
- One (1) current letter of recommendation from teachers, advisors or organization that you volunteered with;
- A brief (no more than 2 pages) autobiography to include your reasons for applying for this scholarship, your proposed field of study and future career plans; any work experience, your interests, and any leadership positions you have held.
