Re: Vice and Narcotics Search Warrant – 12378 Glen Haven Street – Spring Hill

Date: September 13, 2019

On 09-12-19 shortly after 6 a.m., detectives with the Hernando County Sheriff's Office Vice and Narcotics Unit executed a search warrant at 12378 Glen Haven Street in Spring Hill.

The execution of the search warrant was the culmination of a months-long investigation into possible drug activity at the house.

Detectives conducted a thorough search of the residence and located numerous types and amounts of illegal narcotics to include the following:

- Marijuana – 804.4 grams
- Cocaine – 45.7 grams
- Ecstasy – 46 pills/24.8 grams
- Fentanyl patches – 97.3 grams
- THC Vape cartridges – 210 cartridges
- Assorted pills – 77 pills
- LSD – 147 tabs
- THC edibles – 11 pounds
- Weapons – 4 (1 of which was stolen)
- Methamphetamine – 2.2 grams

Of the 11 people found inside the home, nine individuals were arrested. The individuals listed below were arrested on various drug charges. Due to the extensive number of charges, we have provided a link to each person's booking information that includes details pertaining to each of their charges.

The Office of Sheriff:

The Office of the Sheriff is established by the Florida Constitution. As a constitutional officer, the Sheriff has the exclusive authority to administer his or her agency and is responsible for preserving the peace throughout the entire county, carrying out the laws of the state, the orders of Florida courts, and the ordinances of the Board of County Commissioners. The Sheriff is the chief law enforcement and correctional officer of the county.

Sheriff Al Nienhuis was initially appointed as the Sheriff of Hernando County by the Governor in January of 2011. He was then elected by the people of Hernando County in 2012, ran unopposed in 2016, and remains accountable to them.
