Re: Two Spring Hill Men Charged in Connection with Webster Shooting Incident
– 2025-00151434

Date: March 10, 2025

On 03-08-2025 at approximately 12:30 a.m., Hernando County Sheriff's deputies responded to a residence on Ranchette Boulevard in Webster in reference to a shooting.

Witnesses at the scene advised one male victim was shot and that the suspects had fled the area in a Ford F250 truck.

The 18-year-old victim was transported to an area hospital for treatment of a non-life-threatening injury.

The shooting incident occurred following a physical altercation at a party between the victim and another individual, who was later identified as **Daniel Moore DOB/02-25-2005**. Witnesses say during the physical altercation Moore's friend, **Harley Wilkerson DOB/09-14-2004**, fired several rounds from a handgun into the ground in an attempt to break up the fight.

Wilkerson and Moore then entered a Ford F250 with another subject to leave the party. However, as Moore was driving away, Wilkerson fired several rounds from a rifle into a group of people standing outside, with one round striking the victim. The shooting victim was the individual involved in the physical altercation with Moore.

Deputies were able to locate the suspect's vehicle a short time later in the area of Spring Hill Drive and Coronado Drive in Spring Hill. Deputies conducted a traffic stop where they located Wilkerson, Moore and another individual, all of whom had been at the party in Webster.

Deputies observed two firearms in the vehicle to include a rifle and a handgun.

Wilkerson and Moore were both detained at the scene after being positively identified by witnesses as the two individuals involved in the fight and shooting incident who had fled from the scene prior to law enforcement's arrival.

Wilkerson confirmed to detectives that he fired the rounds from the rifle into the crowd.

Wilkerson was arrested on charges of **Attempted Murder in the Second Degree with a Firearm, Aggravated Battery, and Shooting within an Occupied Vehicle with a Deadly Weapon**. He was transported to the Hernando County Detention Center where he is being held without bond.

Moore was arrested on charges of **Accessory After the Fact for Attempted Murder in the Second Degree with a Firearm**. He was transported to the Hernando County Detention Center where he is being held in lieu of a \$5,000 bond.
