On 03-23-2026, **Clint Edward Anderson, DOB 11-12-1973**, was arrested on 2 counts of **Failure to Register Change of Vehicle Ownership Within 48 Hours** and 1 count of **Knowingly Providing False Registration Information by Act or Omission**.

Anderson was adjudicated guilty in 1994, in Lancaster, New Hampshire, for **three (3) counts of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault involving a victim under 13 years of age, Offender 18 Years of Age or Older**. This conviction designated Anderson as a Sexual Offender in the State of Florida, subject to registration requirements.

On 03-23-2026, Detective Marcacci, along with an FDLE Inspector, made contact with Anderson at his permanent residence, located on Deltona Boulevard in Spring Hill. While at the residence, Detective Marcacci conducted a Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Sexual Offender Predator System (SOPS) address verification with Anderson, along with a review of his reported information on his profile.

Upon review, Detective Marcacci noted that Anderson reported in his FDLE SOPS profile on 01-09-2026, that he had obtained ownership of a Ford Escape. No other vehicles were listed in his FDLE SOPS profile.

A Driver and Vehicle Information Database (DAVID) vehicle title history check revealed that the aforementioned vehicle was formerly owned by Anderson's brother, who, per DAVID address records, has been residing with Anderson at his permanent residence since 07-09-2025.

The DAVID record further revealed that his brother also owns a Dodge Challenger, which was not reported on Anderson's FDLE SOPS profile.

Anderson was required to report to his FDLE SOPS both the Ford Escape, as well as the Dodge Challenger.

With Anderson failing to register the change of vehicle ownership within 48 hours to his sex offender profile, as well as knowingly providing false registration information by act or omission when completing his bi-annual registration, he was placed under arrest for the following violations:

**Ct1-2) Failure to Register Change of Vehicle Ownership Within 48 Hours**

**Ct3) Knowingly Providing False Registration Information by Act or Omission**

Anderson was initially held without bond but was later granted a \$60,000 bond at his first appearance.
