What is the Care Line:

The Hernando County Sheriff's Office has established a program for the security and well-being of those people living alone who would like daily contact with someone who cares.

To participate in this program, you can request an application from the Hernando County Sheriff's Office, (352) 797-3660, or go on-line to www.hernandosheriff.org.

The application, properly completed, is also an agreement to comply with procedures essential to make the program successful. A waiver is included, when signed, authorizes a Law Enforcement Officer to enter your residence to check your well-being, should that become necessary.

How the Care Line Works:

- 1. You call us everyday at the designated time to let us know you are ok.
- 2. If we do not receive a call from you, a **Care Line** representative will attempt to call you.
- 3. If we do not make contact, we will then check with the person(s) you listed on your application.
- 4. If this fails, a Law Enforcement Officer will be dispatched to your home to check your well-being.

Our primary concern is to make certain you have not suffered an injury or illness that prevented a response to our call.

When you enroll with Care Line:

- 1. You are required to call the **Care Line** Office at (352) **797-3799** every morning at the designated time between 6:00 a.m. 9:30 a.m.
- 2. If you plan to be away from home for any period of time, you should notify the **Care Line** prior to your departure and again upon your return home.
- 3. We ask that you provide us with the names and phone numbers of neighbors, family, friends (someone local) who would be aware of your daily activities. We will also need the name and number of a relative to contact in case of emergency, even if they live out of town.
