Oftentimes, those with special needs, such as Alzheimer's Disease, Dementia, and Autism, require additional care and monitoring beyond what law enforcement is able to provide.

One way to protect our most vulnerable citizenry is with the latest GPS technology.

This technology works using satellites, and oftentimes can pinpoint exact location, speed of travel, and time of the GPS device instantaneously.

This technology provides family members, who's loved ones tend to wander, piece of mind in knowing their whereabouts at a moment's notice. Finding their exact location is as simple as opening an app on your smart phone or program on your computer.

## What is GPS Tracking

A GPS tracking unit is a navigation device, normally carried by a moving vehicle or person that uses the Global Positioning System (GPS) to track the device's movements and determine its location. The Global Positioning System (GPS) is a network of about 30 satellites orbiting the Earth at an altitude of 20,000 km. Once it has information on how far away at least three satellites are, your GPS receiver can pinpoint your location using a process called trilateration.

The Sheriff's Office has done a brief search of the internet and found just a few different GPS products that are available to the public. Although the Sheriff's Office does not endorse any specific device, we have included some links where citizens can go online and learn about each device in order to choose which one would best fit their situation.
